

Important Update: Emirates Power Bank Regulations Starting 01OCT 2025

Dear Trade Partner,

Greetings from your Emirates BeLux Sales Team!

Effective 1st October 2025, using any kind of power bank is prohibited onboard Emirates.

Emirates customers are still permitted to carry one power bank onboard with specific conditions (listed below).

To further enhance the safety of our customers and crew, Emirates will implement the following guidelines regarding power banks:

- Each passenger is allowed to carry one (1) power bank with a capacity under 100 Watthours (Wh) in their cabin baggage
- Power banks must be carried in hand luggage and clearly display their capacity rating. If the Watt-hours (Wh) capacity cannot be verified, the device will not be accepted at check-in.
- Use of power banks to charge devices onboard is strictly prohibited
- All power banks must have visible and legible capacity information to be accepted for transport
- Power banks must not be stored in the overhead compartment. They should be placed in the seat pocket or in a bag under the seat in front.
- Power banks are not allowed in checked baggage under any circumstances. This was already the case previously.

These enhanced measures are designed to minimise risks associated with power banks during flight.
