Air Canada announces a new direct route between Brussels and Halifax for summer 2026

Brussels, November 25, 2025 - Air Canada is strengthening its presence in Belgium with the launch of a new seasonal route between Brussels and Halifax, the capital of Nova Scotia, starting in summer 2026. This new service, operating three times per week from June 19, 2026, will offer Belgian travelers direct access to Atlantic Canada.

Flights from Brussels to Halifax will be available on Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays from June 19 to September 6, 2026. Flights from Halifax to Brussels will operate on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays from June 18 to September 5, 2026. The route will be served by an aircraft equipped with Premium and Economy cabins, offering optimal comfort for both leisure and business travellers.

“We are very pleased to introduce this new direct route between Brussels and Halifax, which further strengthens the ties between Belgium and Canada,” said Steven De Bisschop, Air Canada’s General Manager for Belgium.

This new route will also allow Canadian travellers to benefit from direct access to Brussels, a true gateway to Europe and Africa thanks to Star Alliance partners.

Members of the Aeroplan loyalty program will be able to earn and redeem points on this new route and enjoy the benefits offered within the Star Alliance network and with Air Canada’s numerous international partners.

This announcement is part of a broader expansion of Air Canada’s international network for summer 2026. In addition to Brussels - Halifax, Air Canada will also launch new direct flights between Montreal and Berlin, Montreal and Nantes, as well as a new route between Toronto and Ponta Delgada in the Azores. The airline will also resume its seasonal Montreal - Tel Aviv service.
