Starting **29 April 2026**, flights will operate **four times per week** and will be served by our modern **Boeing 737 MAX 8** aircraft, offering passengers enhanced comfort, reliability, and a seamless travel experience.

This new service becomes **our second direct connection between Belgium and Poland**, complementing the successful **Brussels–Warsaw** route. With this expansion, we aim to strengthen commercial ties, enrich leisure travel options, and provide our shared customers with even more flexibility and choice.

UPDATE I: New OSI Code for Tour Operator Fares

Please note that the **OSI code for loading LOT Polish Airlines tour operator fares in the GDS has been updated for the upcoming year.**

The **new and correct OSI code is: ITBNLTO.**

The previous code **LO ITBNL** is no longer valid and will be discontinued.

We kindly ask all our Tour Operator partners to update their systems and processes accordingly to ensure correct fare identification and seamless booking handling.

Should you require any assistance from my side regarding this update, I remain at your disposal.

UPDATE II: Modification of Baggage and SSR Codes

We would also like to inform our travel agent partners about recently made modifications to baggage and SSR codes.

Effective 4 December 2025, the following **baggage codes** have been introduced:

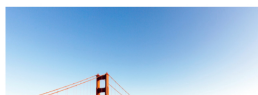
- **ABAG, BBAG, CBAG, XBAG, XBGA**
- For Altea models: **EXBG, EXBA**

At the same time, the following **SSR codes** will be discontinued:

PDVA, PDVB, PDBA

Please ensure your systems and booking procedures are updated accordingly to guarantee correct handling of baggage requests and associated services.

Exciting News: New Direct Route Warsaw–San Francisco



We are thrilled to announce that we will launch a brand-new **direct long-haul route from Warsaw (WAW) to San Francisco (SFO)** as well!



- **First flight:** 6 May 2026
- **Frequency:** 4 times per week, operating during summer seasons only
- **Aircraft:** Boeing 787 Dreamliner

This new service is introduced alongside our **recently announced destinations: Marrakesh, Malaga, Stavanger, Bologna, Heraklion, Porto and Palma de Mallorca**, further expanding our network and travel options from Warsaw.

- **Aircraft:** Boeing 737 MAX 8
- **Start of service:** 31 May 2026
- **Frequency:** 4 times per week during the summer season, 3 times per week during the winter season

Set against the breathtaking backdrop of the **Tian Shan Mountains**, Almaty enchants travelers with its dramatic landscapes, vibrant culture, and unmistakable charm. It is the perfect destination for both **business trips and unforgettable getaways**, where vibrant city life meets spectacular natural scenery.

This new route further strengthens LOT's network in Central Asia, offering even more opportunities for travel between Poland and Kazakhstan.
