IndiGo recognizes that changes to travel plans can cause inconvenience. Customers whose bookings are impacted may opt for alternate flight options or claim a full refund via [Plan B](#).

In their continued effort, they are extending full flexibility and waivers for travel to and from the Middle East, along with other impacted international sectors, **until 7th March 2026, for bookings made on or before 28th February 2026**. Customers may opt for a full refund or reschedule at no additional cost.

Since the situation remains fluid, any further changes will be duly communicated.
